

DO YOU HAVE A SIBLING WHO IS DIAGNOSED WITH AUTISM?

IF YOU ARE BETWEEN 12-18 YEARS OLD AND IMMIGRATED TO CANADA AT SOME POINT IN YOUR LIFE, THIS STUDY MAY BE FOR YOU!

Khad Bint Misbah, M.A., a doctoral student at York University is conducting a research study with young people who have a sibling with autism.

*This study is important because there is little research on what it may be like to live with a brother or sister who has autism, especially among immigrant families. **It is meant to give you a voice!***



What it involves: If eligible, you will be asked to participate in an approx. 30-minute interview where you will have an opportunity to share about what it is like live with a sibling with autism. Interviews will take place online, at York University, or at a

location convenient to you. You will also be asked to complete a short series of questionnaires. **Participants will be entered into a draw to win gift cards (e.g., Amazon or Apple) worth up to \$250!**

Are you eligible?

- 12-18 years old
- Have at least one sibling who is diagnosed with autism whom you live with
- Communicate in the English language
- Immigrated to Canada (at any time in lifetime)
- *NOT* diagnosed with autism
